

SARS takes top honours

SARS last night scooped several major honours at the inaugural Public Service Excellence Awards, including the Grand Prix Platinum award for Best Reputation.

Other awards SARS received included the Gold award for Overall Effectiveness, the Gold Award for Service Orientation, the Gold award for Service Orientation in Rural Areas, as well as the Gold award for Best Reputation in the Financial Services category.
